

OMBTT PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING INDIAN LAKE EVENT #3

BOTH PARTNERS ARE TO FAMILIARIZE THEMSELVES WITH THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS – THEY WILL COMPRISE THE PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING!

- THE START WILL BE BY THE NUMBERS – YOU MUST PASS THE START BOAT WITHIN 50' TO BE PROPERLY RECOGNIZED BY YOUR PLATE NUMBER - DO NOT WAKE THE START BOAT PROCEED A SAFE DISTANCE BEFORE SPEEDING UP.
- THERE WILL BE 3-FLIGHTS. BOAT NUMBERS 1-20 FLIGHT #1 DUE IN: 3:00 pm
BOAT NUMBERS 21-40 FLIGHT #2 DUE IN: 3:15 pm
BOAT NUMBERS 41 -ON FLIGHT #3 DUE IN: 3:30 pm
- THE CHECK-IN BOAT WILL BE LOCATED NEAR THE START OF THE NO-WAKE ZONE AT THE LAKESIDE ENTRANCE AND WILL BE FLYING THE AMERICAN FLAG. You Must Turn In Your Numbered Ball To Be Considered On-Time. Lost Balls Will Incur A \$10 Fine. If You Have To Leave Early, For Any Reason, Leave The Ball At The Trailer In The "LEFT EARLY" Can.
- YOU MAY TRAILER YOUR BOAT OR OFFLOAD SHOREWARD, SECURE YOUR CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. You Must Use An OMBTT Weigh Bag Or Your Own Bas-n-Bag OR Venom's *Bass-ina-Bag* ONLY! You Should Fill Your Bag As Full As Possible With Live Well Water and Proceed To The Weigh-In Area.
- A COURTESY STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR BUMPING YOUR FISH (BY THE GARBAGE CAN)
- DUMP YOUR LIVEWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE CAN Then Proceed Immediately To The Dip Tank Line And Re-Fill Your Bag, Moving Down The Line Until You've Reached The Bump Master – DUMP YOUR BAG WATER AND HAND HIM THE BAG WITH YOUR FISH.
- YOU WILL DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN DEAD FISH – DO NOT LEAVE WEIGH-IN AREA WITHOUT IT.
- A WEIGH SLIP WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE GENERATED, PLEASE TAKE YOURS, ANY ERRORS OR OMISSIONS MUST BE IMMEDIATELY REPORTED OR THEY WILL STAND

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS – INDIAN LAKE EVENT:

- BAGS: You Do Not Have To Buy Your Own Bag – We Do Provide Bags, However, As A Convenience You May Purchase Your Own Bag (It Must Be An Approved Bag). **WE DID NOTICE THAT SEVERAL TEAMS DID NOT FOLLOW THIS DIRECTION – FROM THIS POINT ON IT WILL MEAN IMMEDIATE DISQUALIFICATION.**
- START: Try To Get Yourself In Boat Order Prior To Passing The Start Boat, Second And Third Flights Should Stay Back Some To Allow For The Earlier Flight/s To Get Positioned.
- WEIGH-IN: DUMP YOUR LIVEWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE CAN. Enter The Weigh In Area At The Designated Entry, Check Your Fish And Dump Your Water Prior To Using The Dip Tank.
- You May Trailer Your Boat Or Off-Load Your Catch From A Courtesy (Empty) Dockage.
- Read Your Rules – I Repeat Again, NO FOUL LANGUAGE OF ANY KIND, You Will Be Sorry.
- Read Your Pre-Tournament Meeting – Both Of You (Team) – This Saves Time For Everyone.
- We Will Not Tolerate Unsportsmanlike Conduct Of Any Kind! We Run A Clean, Family Friendly Event And We Will Keep It That Way.
- Weigh-Slips Will Be Available At This Event.
- Our Primary Means Of Communication Is Via Our Website – Please Utilize It For Answers
