IMMEDIATELY AFTER REGISTERING GET IN THE WATER

REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW PENETRATING CULL SYSTEMS.

A RIGS ARE ALLOWED IN ALL OMBTT AND KMTT EVENTS

THE START WILL BE BY THE NUMBERS – YOU MUST PASS THE START BOAT WITHIN 50' TO BE PROPERLY RECOGNIZED BY YOUR BOAT NUMBER - DO NOT WAKE THE START BOAT PROCEED A SAFE DISTANCE BEFORE SPEEDING UP.

FLIGHT #1 BOAT NUMBERS 1-ALL DUE IN: 2:30pm

We do not charge a late fee for ramp entries.

THE CHECK-IN PROCESS WILL BE AS FOLLOWS. The check in boat will be close to the boat ramp flying the American flag. Please give them your ball and give yourself ample time to reach them.

YOU MAY WEIGH FROM WATER OR TRAILER YOUR BOAT SECURE YOU'RE CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. You Should Fill Your Bag As Full As Possible With Live Well Water and Proceed To The Weigh-In Area.

A COURTESY STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR BUMPING YOUR FISH please check your board to ours. **We will not accept excuses that yours is different.**

DUMP YOUR LIVELWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE CAN Then Proceed Immediately To The Dip Tank Line And Re-Fill Your Bag, Moving Down The Line Until You've Reached The Bump Master – DUMP YOUR BAG WATER AND HAND HIM THE BAG WITH YOUR FISH. **YOU WILL DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN DEAD FISH.**

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS –INDIAN LAKE

- 1. THE LAKE HAS A NO WAKE AREA'S. ADHEAR TO ALL THE NO WAKE ZONES! THE LAKE IS NO WAKE 300 FT FROM ANY SHORELINE. DO NOT PASS A BOAT WHO HAS SET DOWN IN THAT DISTANCE TO IDLE TO THE BANK OR A CUT.**
- 2. IF YOU SEE A VIOLATION, PLEASE GET VIDEO OR PICS AND FILE A PROTEST. REMEMBER WE CAN'T DO ANYTHING WITHOUT YOU FILING FOR A PROTEST. (Never happens but we want you to know the process)**
- 3. WE WILL DRAW 3 NUMBERS FOR A TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE. THEY ARE 2/11/20**
- 4. BIG BASS AND TIE BREAKERS MUST BE A LIVE FISH. NO DEAD FISH MAY BE WEIGHED FOR BIG BASS AND TWO BB ARE PAID AT EACH OPEN EVENT 70/30**
- 5. YOU MUST BE CULLED TO THE TOURNAMENT LIMIT BEFORE CHECKING IN.**
- 6. Fish are stressed in this kind of heat. Please keep livewells running and ice is a very good idea. Also if at all possible try not to use any cull clips other than to balance beam fish.**
- 7. WE WILL NOT TOLERATE UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT. Don't do unto others that you would not want done to you.**
