We offer a 10.00 optional big bass side pot and pay 100% of that back for the (2) biggest live bass at each event. The split will be 70% to the biggest bass along with a trophy and 30% to the second big bass.

LIVE Big bass of the year is a 20.00 one time optional side pot. 100% of that pot will go to the biggest bass of the year with a trophy.

Platinum side pot is an optional 50.00 entry at each event. Only the teams who get it this pot are qualified to win it. The top 3 teams in this pot will split the pot 50%/30%/20%. If less than 6 teams we will pay one spot only.

12Lb Pot is optional 10.00 at each event. The highest finishing team in the pot weighing 12lbs or more will win the pot. At the last event will be paid regardless of weight.

RULES GENERALLY:

1. **SAFETY:** PFD's must be worn at all times when exceeding idle speed.
2. **LIMITE/CREEL:** Shall be five (5) fish, twelve inches or greater in length, measured with the mouth closed, tail brushed. Participants WILL NOT trailer or sack their catch with more than the tournament limit in the live well.
3. **PERMITTED FISHING METHODS:** All bass must be caught utilizing conventional angling methods. A-Rigs are permitted.
4. **DEAD/SHORT FISH:** Dead fish will incur an 8-ounce penalty. Short fish will incur a 1-pound penalty. Fish presented for weight, which DO NOT APPEAR to be in "healthy" condition, as determined by the tournament officials, and which may exhibit signs of "livekeep abuse" containment, will be refused at the scales.
5. **MAKE UP EVENT:** Will count as an event fished for classic qualifications. This is nothing more than an accommodation for those who have a conflict and cant make a scheduled circuit event. No points are awarded and money is kept back for the classic. It is open to everyone and No membership will be required.
6. **WEIGH-INS:** You will fill the bag with a sufficient amount of water so as to not unduly stress the catch when bringing to scale. You will be notified whether you have to return the catch to the lake or if the circuit will release the catch.
7. **BIG BASS:** Only live big bass can be weighed.
8. **CULLING:** Only non penetrating cull systems may be used. And your catch must be culled to the 5 fish limit before checking in.
9. **ALTERNATES:** 2026 We will continue to have two alternate's maximum per year for poinmember must fish with an alternate. Alternates may not fish alone or with another alternate.
10. **CLASSIC ALTERNATE:** Will be permitted as long as you partner with another KMTT classic qualified member that does not have a partner forts purposes. One team the classic.
11. **CLASSIC QUALIFICATION:** Each team must have paid their full event entry for 6 of the 7 circuit events. Each team member must have fished a minimum of 4 events. You may also partner with another member who is also qualified for the OMBTT classic if both your partners are unable to attend.

GENERAL

You asked for it, you now have it, 7 Events with a classic! KMTT classic at Lake Erie limited to Sandusky Bay only. Both Largemouth and Smallmouth. AOY receives 600.00 cash

We now have a make-up event 06/28 at Alum Creek. No points are awarded but it does count as an event fished for classic qualification purposes. Open to everyone and no membership required.

We require 50.00 per event deposit (300) and membership (50) \$350.00 total to fish the 2026 season. No single event entry's. Remaining balance for each event due before each event begins.

All teams that fished at least 5 events the previous season will be guaranteed a spot till 02/01/2026.
