 Friday 10/15 Wind date in case of a cancelation (7:35-5:00pm)

THE CHECK-IN BOAT WILL BE LOCATED IN FRONT OF THE RAMPS FLYING THE AMERICAN FLAG OR SET UP ON THE DOCKS. YOU MAY WEIGH FROM WATER OR TRAILER YOUR BOAT SECURE YOU'RE CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. BE CAREFULL WITH THE WING DAM IN FRONT OF ELIZABETH RAMP! MOST OF THE TIME YOU CAN'T MAKE IT OVER TOP. EXIT AT BOTH ENDS.

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR CLASSIC

1. LIFE JACKETS MUST BE WORN WHEN OPERATING ABOVE NO WAKE BUT WE RECOMMEND WEARING AT ALL TIMES DUE TO THE CURRENT!
2. WE WILL NOT TOLERATE UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT. Don't do unto others that you would not want done to you.
2. Remember the RIVER has no-wake areas please adhere to them and do not pass anyone in a no-wake zone. Be sure you look up these areas in the river that are no wake. If you get a ticket your DQ'd. I heard they were ticketing in areas anglers were not used to being enforced earlier in the year. (Your responsibility to know these areas)
3. If you see a violation get a pic or video with your phone and file a protest. We can't do anything without a protest being filed.
4. Remember any OMBTT run events do not allow a-rigs or penetrating cull systems.
5. Due to Covid and me not being able to get off work we have decided to do the paper meeting instead of 60+ anglers meeting in confined area. Two Ohio tournament directors have recently had to battle Covid. I do not want to be number 3! Let's keep it outdoors!
6. Entry is 200.00 per boat with optional \$50 Platinum Pot both days and \$20 Big Bass each day with 2 big bass pd each day. Don't forget we are also having a day 2 biggest bag award for \$500.00. If you have a bad day one you can still win some money! Projected payouts are up on classic page WWW.OMBTT.COM
7. There are wildlife area's that are off limits as well as some private area's so be sure it is legal to be fishing where you are. This mostly pertain to some backwaters.
8. The boat ramp area from the northernmost edge of the marina to the Grosse Isle bridge abutments is off limits to fishing.
9. Michigan does not allow power loading. Do not power load at the ramps you may get ticketed.
10. Make sure you have all the required safety gear to be on the great lakes! Flares must not be expired either.
11. You must cull down to 5 fish before checking in and adhere to state creel limits.
12. To everyone who has fished with OMBTT and our other trails we thank you for your support. You have so many options out there and we appreciate you picking us.

14. If we have to cancel a day the lake and all connected waterways are off limits.
