IMMEDIATELY AFTER REGISTERING GET IN THE WATER

REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW PENETRATING CULL SYSTEMS.

THE START WILL BE BY THE NUMBERS – YOU MUST PASS THE START BOAT WITHIN 50' TO BE PROPERLY RECOGNIZED BY YOUR PLATE NUMBER - DO NOT WAKE THE START BOAT PROCEED A SAFE DISTANCE BEFORE SPEEDING UP.

FLIGHT #1 BOAT NUMBERS 1-21 DUE IN: 2:30pm
FLIGHT #2 BOAT NUMBERS 22-REMAINING DUE IN: 2:45 pm

THE CHECK-IN BOAT WILL BE LOCATED IN FRONT OF THE RAMPS FLYING THE AMERICAN FLAG. YOU ARE CHECKED IN WHEN YOU GIVE YOUR NUMBR TO THE CK IN BOATOR CK IN WITH US.

YOU MAY WEIGH FROM WATER OR TRAILER YOUR BOAT SECURE YOU'RE CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. You Must Use your own Weigh Bag only if you do not have one we have some throw away bags. You Should Fill Your Bag As Full As Possible With Live Well Water and Proceed To The Weigh-In Area.

A COURTESY STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR BUMPING YOUR FISH please check your board to ours. We will not accept excuses that yours are different.

DUMP YOUR LIVEWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE CAN Then Proceed Immediately To The Dip Tank Line And Re-Fill Your Bag, Moving Down The Line Until You've Reached The Bump Master – DUMP YOUR BAG WATER AND HAND HIM THE BAG WITH YOUR FISH.

YOU WILL DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN DEAD FISH!

In the same regards if you want to go to a certain side of the lake and you are on the other side of the lake shame on you. The field is not going to slow down to wait for you to cross the lake up north. The key to not having problems is always communication. Whenever you're not sure just ask the other party if it is ok.

6. Also, we do not want folks pushing it too hard up North in the no wake zone. You do not have to crawl but do not be running so hard you are leaving a big wave and your plowing.
