BIG BASS: Competitors may choose only one live bass out of their bag as an entry into the "big-bass side pot/s" or as a tiebreaker...

LATE PENALTY: One-pound per minute after the designated end time, up to five-minutes, after which time the competitor/ s will be automatically disqualified.

DEAD/SHORT FISH: Every effort shall be made to keep the catch in a viable state of health. Dead fish presented for weight shall incur an eight (8) ounce penalty. Participants will be responsible for disposing of their own dead fish in an appropriate manner so as not to negatively impact future OMBTT tournament activities. Short fish will incur a one (1) pound penalty.

50-YARD RULE: Competitors may not fish within a 50-yard radius of another competitors boat which was first anchored with its trolling motor up and stowed, however, anchored boats may not prevent access, to and from, areas outside of the 50-yard radius (such as coves, creeks, etc.) Use of mechanical or staked anchoring systems are recognized as "anchored". You may not anchor and ask a boat already within you radius to leave.

TIES: Will be broken by first; total live fish weighed, second; total fish weighed, third; big bass of the bag and fourth; if everything else is equal, a toss of a coin or agreement by both teams to split the 2 places. If the tie is for big bass, then KNOWLEDGE OF THESE RULES IS YOUR RESPONSIBILITY: Failure prize money is split and the BB plaque awarded by coin toss.

CLASSIC TIE 1ST: In case of a tie for 1st Place; teams will be sent out for a one-hour fish-off, team with the heaviest weight will win, if still tied; number of fish, then big bass, if still tied, flip of the coin (or splitting of the 1st and 2nd Place purses).

LEAVING THE BOAT: If an angler needs to leave the boat due to an emergency, or to use the bathroom, etc., the partner must immediately cease fishing until such time as the partner returns. Normally, depending on what is announced at the start of the tournament, this means returning to the launch site and using the facilities there.

BREAKDOWNS: Teams may choose to double-up with another team in order to bring their catch to the scale, provided, however, that the catch is kept separate and/or distinctively marked.

INSURANCE/LIABILITY: Each boater, as a condition of participating in these events, shall carry a minimum of \$300,000 liability insurance. Participants, by participating in any sponsored OMBTT event(s) and as a condition of participating. agree to hold everyone associated with these events harmless in case of injury or death.

DISBURSEMENT/PAYOUTS: 70% of paid entrant fees shall be paid out at each event (\$140) with the remaining 30% set aside for the Classic Championship (\$60). The OMBTT will post all payouts on an event-by-event basis so as to uphold the highest levels of accountability to its membership. All teams MUST have their individual SSN on file prior to the disbursement of any Place money which may be awarded as a single check. Each team member will be credited with onehalf (1/2) of the amount awarded for IRS reporting purposes (IRS1099).

QUALITY ASSURANCE TESTING: By their signature on the entry form and/or participation in these tournaments, all participants agree to any quality assurance tests as required by the Directors. They may include all or part of the following; polygraph test, urinalysis, blood test, and/or observer in or out of the boat. Refusal of anglers to submit will result in immediate **CULLING:** Teams must have culled to the tournament limit disqualification plus subsequent disqualification from future tournaments. None of the above rules shall prohibit the Director/s or an authorized member of the Tournament Committee from observing, approaching or boarding a competitor's boat during official tournament hours. Quality assurance tests will be conducted as soon as possible after conclusion of official tournament hours.

> THE COMMITTEE: A committee of "the whole": Tournament Committee, will be appointed by the director/s at each event by drawing the three (3) teams from the field. This committee will address all issues of note. If, for any reason, one (or more) of the drawn teams are themselves a subject of rules violation, then another team will be drawn to take their place.

> to read these rules and/or ignorance of these rules is not an excuse for prohibited conduct. Any extreme violation of rules will be grounds for disqualification from all future OMBTT events. Any announcement made by the Director/s at tournament sites takes precedence over written rules if in conflict with same.

> PRESUMPTIVE CONDUCT: Defined as intra-team interaction on the water, as an example, contestants who were FIRST AN-CHORED OR TIED TO a fixed-point, with their trolling motor stowed (up) and prior to the arrival of another competitor's boat may claim exclusivity within a 50 yard radius of their boat. This does apply to those instances where the boat claiming the exclusivity is blocking access to "another area" (creek, bay, slough, etc.) in those cases, egress shall be allowed to other competitors boats. Competitors boats which are obviously fishing in a fixed position, such as on a point, should, as a matter of courtesy, be given a wide berth when approaching, going around and going away from, as a matter of good sportsmanship. Conduct prior to, as well as after the conclusion of the event and while still at site, must reflect the highest standard of sportsmanship. Cursing, fighting words, and any other action or conduct which may reflect negatively on the series or its competitors, will not be tolerated and may result in disqualification from further events.

> PERMITTED TACKLE/ANGLING METHODS: All bass must be caught live and in a conventional sporting manner using only one casting, spin casting or spinning rod, 10-foot or less. measured butt to tip, in hand contact, may be used at any one time. A hung lure, or lures attached to additional rods will be what is commonly referred to as pork or pork rind. The use of umbrella rigs and other such contrivances, which attach to the main line end forming an apex for additional arms/lines to which more than one lure is displayed, are prohibited, as are any "arrayed lures", described as anything attached to a horizontal plane and which use one, or more, hooks, either as an attractor or as a standalone unit, are also prohibited.
