IMMEDIATELY AFTER REGISTERING GET IN THE WATER

REMEMBER WE DO NOT ALLOW PENETRATING CULL SYSTEMS OR A-RIGS.

We are sticklers about launching at safe light. Do not be late for registration!
THE START WILL BE BY THE NUMBERS – YOU MUST PASS THE START BOAT WITHIN 50' TO BE PROPERLY RECOGNIZED BY YOUR PLATE NUMBER - DO NOT WAKE THE START BOAT
PROCEED A SAFE DISTANCE BEFORE SPEEDING UP.

FLIGHT #1 BOAT NUMBERS 1-ALL DUE IN: 4:00 pm

THE CHECK-IN PERSON WILL BE LOCATED IN PARKING LOT BY THE RAMP. WE WILL BE LOOKING FOR LATE BOATS SO NO NEED TO CHECK IN WITH US.

YOU MAY WEIGH FROM WATER OR TRAILER YOUR BOAT SECURE YOU'RE CATCH AND THEN PROCEED TO THE WEIGH-IN AREA. You Must Use your own Weigh Bag only if you do not have one, we have some throw away bags. You Should Fill Your Bag as Full As Possible With Live Well Water and Proceed To The Weigh-In Area.

A COURTESY STATION HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR BUMPING YOUR FISH please check your board to ours. We will not accept excuses that yours are different.

DUMP YOUR LIVEWELL WATER IN THE GARBAGE CAN Then Proceed Immediately to The Dip Tank Line and Re-Fill Your Bag, Moving Down the Line Until You've Reached the Bump Master – DUMP YOUR BAG WATER AND HAND HIM THE BAG WITH YOUR FISH.
YOU WILL DISPOSE OF YOUR OWN DEAD FISH!

SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS – LAKE ERIE PRO OPEN

1. WE WILL NOT TOLERATE UNSPORTSMAN LIKE CONDUCT. Don't do unto others that you would not want done to you.
2. Remember WE A STICKLERS ABOUT FISH CARE!
 - a.) Bring ice in a cooler for when you are returning.
 - b.) Bring fin weights or something to fizz fish if needed.
 - c.) Do not put any bay water in your live well when returning switch to recirculate before entering the bay.
 - d.) To keep water in your live well while running I put a cork in the overfill drain in the live well, so water does not come out. Just remember you have done so and switch to recirculate, or it will spill into the boat.
 - e.) I have given plenty of time do not beat up your fish. If you bring them to me and most are dead, de scaled or bleeding I will not weigh them.
3. If you see a violation get a pic or video with your phone and file a protest. We can't do anything without a protest being filed.
4. You must wear a life jacket anytime your boat is above no wake (Running fast or on pad) It is your choice on jackets when running in the no wake zones or idling.
